Recommended accommodation for September 17th to 18th

Due to a large fair taking place in Cologne during the conference period, securing accommodation in the city centre become both challenging and costly. As an alternative, we **recommend lodging at the conference venue, Kloster Steinfeld, on September 17**th. The rate for a double room, inclusive of breakfast, is 122 Euros per night. Additionally, a shuttle bus to the venue will be arranged for the evening of September 17th. Please be aware that this night has to be SELF-PAID.

• Transport from and to Cologne Centre Station

Transportation from Cologne Bonn Airport (CGN) or Dusseldorf Airport (DUS) to the city centre of Cologne is convenient and readily available. You can either take a taxi directly from the airport or use the public transport.

If you opt for public transport, trains operate 24 hours a day. You can buy tickets online (https://int.bahn.de/en) or at the ticket machines at the airport station. The machines support English and 5 other languages. When purchasing your ticket, you will need to specify your final destination, i.e., Köln Hbf (Cologne Central Station). You can pay with coins, credit cards (VISA and Mastercard), and debit cards (Maestro). Please note that ticket machines do NOT accept notes. Here are some public transport options available for your journey:

Travel between Cologne Bonn Airport (Köln/Bonn Flughafen) and Cologne Central Station (Köln Hbf)

Travel between Dusseldorf Airport (Düsseldorf Flughafen) and Cologne Central Station (Köln Hbf)

Shuttle bus to the conference venue
